## **VBS 2019 MISSION** **OUTREACH-DONATIONS**

**SPCA of Montgomery County.** The Montgomery County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals is a nonprofit organization dedicated to caring for unwanted, lost and abused domestic animals. **Items to donate:** floor cleaner, old and new towels, cat/dog dry food (no Gravy Train please), guinea pig/rabbit food, hand sanitizer

**Cradles to Crayons.** Cradles to Crayons provides children from birth through age 12, living in homeless or low-income situations, with the essential items they need to thrive – at home, at school and at play. They supply these items free of charge by engaging and connecting communities that have with communities that need.

**Items to donate:** Shorts-Boys sizes 5/6, Shirts/Tops-Boys sizes 14/16 & 18/20, Girls sizes 18-24, 2T, 18/20(Adult M), New Underwear and Spring/Summer Pajama, All gender and sizes, Books, Baby Board Books(0-2 years), Pre-teenage chapter books (11-12 years), Sneakers, Boys and girls sizes 0-1 (Infant/Toddler) to 9.5 (Youth/Adult), Nursery Items- Infant Bath Tubs, Baby Carries, Diaper Bags, ALWAYS in need of boys pants, all sizes, all kinds, and all season long (Long pants, sweatpants, jean shorts, gym shorts, etc.)

**Interfaith Food Pantry.** The interfaith food pantry recently made a move to its new home at Living Word Lutheran Church on Easton Road in Roslyn. Summer is always a difficult time for families with food insecurity- kids are not at school where there are opportunities for reduced or free breakfast and lunch. The food pantry is always in need in the summer months. Bring your non-perishable items to the church all throughout June. We hope to deliver a large load of food, paper goods and supplies to help our community to fight hunger.
