Sample Letters

1. **State the issue you are writing about**—I am concerned about, writing about artificial intelligence, the Senate role in advise and consent, education, immigration, your opinion about a proposed piece of legislation.
2. **State what you want the legislator to do**—please oppose (support) data centers in Pennsylvania; Should we rush to win the AI race against China or slow down the efforts? (suggested question provided by PoliticsPA, June 30, 2026), please oppose (support) confirmation of attorney-general, please increase (decrease) the role of the federal government in education, as examples.

Example: the John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act (suggested by People for the American Way) -- The right to vote is the foundation of our democracy, and no state should be allowed to pass discriminatory voting rules or manipulate district maps to silence communities and dilute the power of voters of color.

3. **State why this issue matters to you**—depending on how passionate you are about this issue, this can be a sentence or a sharing of a personal experience.

Your letter can end up being three or so sentences; simply stated, clear in your wishes for what you want the legislator to do.
